- 1. Times New Roman Font 12pt**
- 2. 1 inch margins on all sides**
- 3. Double Spaced**
- 4. Running Head & Page Number (on all pages)**
- 5. Title Page (not bold)**
- 6. Intro Title (not bold)**
- 7. Level I headers are bold and centered**
- 8. Level II headers are bold and left aligned**
- 9. Reference Title (not bold)**
