



Dallas Christian Academy Remote Education Plan

With the advent of bad weather, questions often arise regarding how class cancellations due to inclement weather and other events affecting the school campus will be handled. To prepare parents (and their students) for these events, Dallas Christian Academy is providing the standard procedures below. Please note that school closure due to inclement weather will be posted on the Dallas Independent School District website at: www.dallasisd.org. All non-weather related campus closures will be posted on the Dallas Christian Academy website at: www.dallaschristianacademy.org.

Weather Related Closings –

Dallas Christian Academy follows the Dallas Independent School District's recommendations/guidelines for weather related school closings. This information can be found on the DISD website, on the website lists published by the metroplex's major news outlets, or on the television and radio lists broadcast by area network television and radio stations.

Facility Related Closings –

In the event of a facility related issue that warrants the closing of Dallas Christian Academy's campus, information will be posted on the school website at: www.dallaschristianacademy.org. Parents and students will also be notified using Facebook, email, text, or phone, through the messaging services provided by One Call Now.

Extended Closing – Remote Education Plan

Should Dallas Christian Academy's campus close for more than two days due to weather or facility issues, the following plan will be enacted.

- Notice of campus closure will be posted on the school's website and Facebook account.
- Families will be notified of the closure through the email addresses and phone numbers provided to the school office.
- One Call Now will be used to give families instructions to begin remote lessons using the auditory and text notification services provided.
- Remote education lesson plans and instructions for completion will be posted on the school website.
- Links from the DCA Facebook page to remote lessons and instructions will be activated.

- Up to five days of emergency remote lessons will be available for use should the facility/disaster event require the closing of the school campus for an extended length of time.

Alternative Delivery Option (Non-Internet)

Each family will be provided with a remote education resource packet at the start of the school year. Families may choose the paper or CD-Rom option during the registration process. In the event of a weather or facility related campus closure that extends beyond the two “snow days” built into the school calendar, families will be provided (via phone or text message) with lesson directions and guidelines for use of the resources contained in the remote education packets. Instructions will be provided in this way for the length of the school closure.
